

KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM

Kindergarten at Children of the Earth Montessori School is a full day program. Children attending kindergarten spend their morning in a regular Primary Montessori Classroom where they receive lessons from the core curriculum areas (Practical Life, Language Arts, Art, Sensory-Motor, Mathematics, Geography, and Science). In the afternoon, the Kindergarten students have time to work with their peers and practice their independent thinking and learning skills.

The Kindergarten program at Children of the Earth Montessori School offers a wealth of extensions to the regular Montessori curriculum as well as opportunities to experience more in-depth advance study from a designated work book, and science experimentation.



The Kindergarten year is the culmination of the Montessori Primary program two/three year cycle. It is in this year that the child is able to make concrete all the information they have been absorbing for the previous two years. During the Kindergarten year, children have the opportunity to be role models for the younger children and finally become class leaders. It is during this year that the children truly blossom and reap the rewards of all they have been working so hard to achieve.
